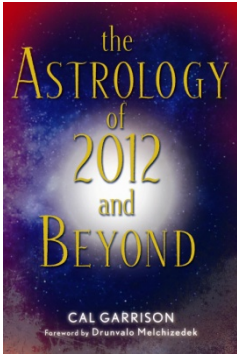

THE ASTROLOGY OF 2012 AND BEYOND by Cal Garrison



In October 2007, a new phenomenon appeared in the sky, named the Comet Holmes, it is being claimed and acclaimed by the Hopi Nation as the Blue Star of their prophecy. The Blue Star is the harbinger. Between now and somewhere in 2013/2014, when the Red Star appears, great shifts in human consciousness will continue. With the fulfillment of the Mayan Long calendar in 2012 and the appearance of the Red Star, many are predicting that human consciousness will rise to the next level. Although there may be catastrophic events associated with this period, and life as we know it will surely change, if we do the work, this is not the apocalypse.

In *The Astrology of 2012 and Beyond*, Garrison explores the changing sky, starting with the movement of Pluto into Capricorn, a region it hasn't inhabited since 1733. A detailed astrological guide for the time between the Blue Star appearing (in 2007) and the Red Star's predicted appearance (2013/14), at a time which roughly coincides with the end of the Mayan long calendar and widely regarded as a time of great shifts by almost all indigenous spiritual systems, Garrison's book will be the first to explore the astrology of this period.
