#### **THE WORLD OF TIVI ETOK by Jobie Weetaluktuk and Robyn Bryant**

Reading these stories we are carried away into a world of discovery filled with knowledge and rich with the complexity of the life of the well-known Inuit Engraver, Tivi Etok.

The book contains the actual words of an Inuit hunter and artist who lived his entire life in northern Quebec and Labrador : the future National Park of Torngat Montains and Koroc river (the book reproduce spectacular photographies of this territory). It is a record of his travels, his hopes, his experiences and his observations. Reading these stories we are carried away into a world of discovery filled with knowledge and rich with the complexity of a full life. This book of Tivi Etok's interviews and stonecuts is a valuable source of wisdom and teachings, worthy of close examination.
